



RULES CALL FOR POLINIZA DOS 2022 (URBAN ART MEETING)

1. PURPOSE

Within the program of activities for POLINIZA DOS 2022 (Urban Art Meeting), the Office of Cultural Action of the Vice-Rectorate of Art, Science, Society and Technology of the Universitat Politècnica de València is organizing an event featuring artistic interventions on campus. The interventions will consist of murals on an architectural surface related to the plastic material and symbolically with its urban environment, as well as ephemeral interventions in the space.

2. PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS

The call is open to all artists, of adult age, interested in participating in the event individually or as a group.

If selected, those chosen by the Selection Committee must present a project aimed at creating a painting intervention from May 16 to May 20, 2022 (both inclusive), every day between 10:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m., on the walls designated for that purpose at UPV's Vera Campus site.

3. REGISTRATION APPLICATION AND DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION

The deadline for registration and submitting applications will be from from the day following the publication of this excerpt in the Official Gazette of the Generalitat Valenciana and until March 21 (both inclusive). To complete the process, the applicant must fill out the application available at the websites <https://acts.webs.upv.es/> and www.upv.es/poliniza. This request must include any link that connects the applicant's digital portfolio or website to the work of the interested party.

This document must be submitted as follows:

- **For applicants who are part of UPV's university community:** they must submit it to UPV's electronic office <https://sede.upv.es>, or through the State Administration's Common Electronic Registry, which is done through the following link:

For the other applicants: in any of UPV's registration offices, both electronic and physical, or by any of the means established in article 16.4 of Law 39/2015, of October 1, on the Common Administrative Procedure of Public Administrations, submitting the request to the **Office of Cultural Action**.

Only in the **extraordinary case** that an applicant does not have a digital certificate, nor is it possible for them to submit the request by any of the means established in article 16.4 of Law 39/2015, of October 1, the applicant may request assistance to electronically process their participation application by sending an email with the application, as per the established form, to the email address **cultura@upv.es** expressly indicating that they provide their consent to electronically process their participation application through a person ascribed to the Vice Rectorate of Art, Science, Technology and Society. **This request for support in submitting the application may only be done until the day before the day of the final deadline for submitting applications.**

4. SELECTION COMMITTEE

The Selection Committee will be comprised of the following members of the Universitat Politècnica de València: the Director of the Office for Cultural Action, the Vice Dean of Culture of the Faculty of Fine Arts, a professor in the Engineering School, the commissioner of POLINIZA DOS, the coordinator of POLINIZA DOS and a student body representative.

After evaluating the information provided, the Selection Committee will select the participants for POLINIZA DOS. In turn, the candidates chosen must submit a sketch of the intervention within 15 natural days, counted from the announcement of the final decision that awarded them. They must also commit to create their work under the terms established in these rules.

The jury will operate in accordance with the rules of the collegiate bodies established in Law 40/2015 on the legal regime of the public sector.

5. EVALUATION CRITERIA

The grants will be awarded through the competitive contest regime.

The applicable evaluation scales and criteria will be objective, non-discriminatory and must respect the principle of equality.

The applications submitted will be scored based on the following criteria:

- Academic record and/or artistic curriculum: 30%
- Portfolio (website, social media, etc.): 70%

6. FINAL DECISION

The final decision will be issued by the Rector within the 5 days following the acceptance of the proposal. The short time window is due to the administrative challenges posed as a result of being an international call.

7. AWARD

The total amount of the grant is 2,400 euros, charged to the budget item 009010000-422-47110. The award, for each artist or group will be 600 gross euros (to be paid via bank transfer) for each intervention completed. There will be a maximum of 4 interventions (individual or group). The organization also assumes the costs of travel, accommodation and living expenses of the artists selected. In addition, they will be provided with the materials necessary for executing the project. The awards will be subject to the corresponding tax withholding.

On occasion, and upon request by the jury, a runner-up may be included to recognize the merit of a proposal that was not awarded. This runner-up will not receive any payment.

8. PROJECT EXECUTION CONDITIONS

The author or group selected undertakes to carry out the project submitted within the period established by these rules.

For its part, the Vice Rectorate of Art, Science, Technology and Society undertakes to disseminate the award through its customary means and provide the infrastructure and materials necessary to execute each project selected.

The artists grant to UPV free-of-charge the rights of reproduction, distribution, public communication and transformation for their works. UPV may possess these works for any amount of time and global in nature. It may also determine how long it remains in the performance space, which in some cases, may be longer than the period between consecutive editions.

9. ACCEPTANCE OF THE RULES

Participation in this call implies full agreement and acceptance of these Rules.

10. DATA PROTECTION

In accordance with the provisions set forth in the EU General Data Protection Regulation 2016/679 and Organic Law 3/2018, of December 5, on Personal Data Protection and the guarantee of digital rights, we hereby inform you that the controller of the data subject to this call is the Universitat Politècnica de València. The legal basis for processing your personal data is the need to manage the award granting procedure of this call. No international disclosures or transfers of the personal data processed is expected. The interested parties will be able to exercise the rights of access, rectification, suppression, portability, limitation or objection to the processing, by providing a copy of an official document that identifies them, and if applicable, the accredited documentation of their request before the Data Protection Officer of the Universitat Politècnica de València, General Secretary. Universitat Politècnica de València, Camí de Vera, s/n 46022-València. In the event of a claim, the competent authority is the

Spanish Data Protection Agency. The data will be stored by virtue of the legislation applicable to this processing.

11. APPLICABLE APPEALS AGAINST THE RESOLUTION

An administrative reconsideration appeal may be lodged against this contest and its bases before the UPV Rectorate, as well as against the decision of this call, after having exhausted the administrative route, within a period of one month, counted from the date following its publication, as stipulated in articles 123 and 124 of Law 39/2015, of October 1, of the Common Administrative Procedure of Public Administrations, or a contentious-administrative appeal before the contentious-administrative jurisdiction bodies of the Valencian Community, within two months counted from the day following the day of the notification of this decision, in accordance with articles 14 and 46 of Law 29/1998, of July 13, regulating the Contentious-Administrative Jurisdiction.
