



Final decision of the Rector of the Universitat Politècnica de València, convening the Poliniza Dos contest to participate in the upcoming edition of Poliniza Dos 2024, organized by the Office of Cultural Action of the Vice Rectorate of Art, Science, Technology and Society.

The contest will be governed by the Rules that appear in the annex to this Call:

FIRST. PURPOSE OF THE CALL

The purpose of this Call is to select five artists to execute artistic interventions in the public space of the Universitat Politècnica de València, which comply with the requirements stipulated in the Governing Rules of the procedure.

SECOND. BUDGET ALLOCATION AND AMOUNT OF THE GRANTS

This Call will be funded by the 009010000-422-40000 budget line for a total amount of **€3,000**, charged to the 2024 budget, and there is adequate and sufficient budget allocation.

Each one of the five awards has been allocated €600.

Each one of the grants has been allocated €600, each one corresponding to the five awards that are granted to execute the artistic interventions.

In addition to this allocation, the Poliniza Dos 2024 Call includes an additional one for the creation of the interventions, as well as travel, accommodation and living expenses.

The economic allocation of the grant will be subject to the corresponding withholding established in the regulations in force.

THIRD. APPLICANTS

The Call is open to artists of adult age interested in participating in the event individually or as a group.

Once the Committee has made the selection, applicants must present a project aimed at executing an artistic intervention from **May 13 to 17, 2024** (both inclusive), on the walls or spaces designated for that purpose at UPV's Vera Campus site

Grant applicants must comply with the following requirements upon completion of the application deadline:

They must have completed and sent the form with the registration application within the period indicated and with the information requested.

FOURTH. DOCUMENTATION AND DEADLINE TO SUBMIT APPLICATIONS

The application submission period starts from the day following the publication of the excerpt of this final decision in the Official Gazette of the Generalitat Valenciana and ends **March 31, 2024**

If the application does not meet the requirements established in the Call Regulations, the competent body will require the interested party to rectify it within the **maximum and non-extendable period of 5 days**. This period is due to the administrative challenges posed as a result of being an international call. The interested party will be informed that failure to do so will result in their application being rejected.

Submission of the application implies acceptance of the Rules, as well as the own obligations derived from the legal framework regarding grants and subsidies.

FIFTH. GOVERNING BODY AND SELECTION COMMITTEE

The competent body for governing the procedure is the Vice Rectorate of Art, Science, Technology and Society. The means of publication of any act that is issued will be the websites <https://acts.webs.upv.es/> and <https://polinizados.webs.upv.es/>

A Selection Committee will be assigned with evaluating the applications and nominating the winners. In all cases, the Decision-Making Body will scale up the proposal to the Rector for the final decision.

The Governing Body may declare any of the awards to be null and void due to the candidates not reaching the quality demanded or for other reasons that would be duly justified, elevating the proposal to the Rector for the final decision.

The Governing Body will resolve the incidents that may arise throughout the Call with objectivity and transparency.

The Governing Body and Selection Committee of the Call undertake not to disclose, transmit or reveal to third parties any information of own interest or third-part interest in relation to the projects presented.

SIXTH. EVALUATION CRITERIA

The grants will be awarded through the competitive contest regime.

The applicable evaluation scales and criteria will be objective, non-discriminatory and must respect the principle of equality.

The applications submitted will be scored based on the following criteria:

- Academic record and/or artistic curriculum: 30%
- Portfolio (website, social media, etc.): 70%

SEVENTH. RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS OF THE BENEFICIARIES

The grant beneficiaries are obliged to:

- Accept the Rules of this Call
- Accept the own obligations derived from the legal framework regarding grants and subsidies.



The violation of these obligations, as well as the failure to submit the corresponding justification documentation will result in losing the grant, and if applicable, returning the sums already received.

The authors of the submitted bids will freely grant the rights of reproduction, transformation and public communication to UPV globally and without any time limit, and without it implying any type of payment or consideration beyond what is associated with the contest award.

EIGHTH. SELECTION AND DECISION-MAKING PROCEDURE

The awarding procedure consists of the following processes:

1. Application submission: along with the rest of the documentation, the applications must be submitted in the manner, place and time stipulated in the third clause of the Call. Submission of the application implies acceptance of these Rules, as well as the own obligations derived from the legal framework regarding grants and subsidies.
2. Publication of the provisional list of accepted and excluded applicants: the Governing Body will publish the provisional list of accepted and excluded applicants on the websites <https://acts.webs.upv.es/> and <https://polinizados.webs.upv.es/> and if applicable, it will indicate the reasons for exclusion.

The interested parties will have a period of 5 days to provide the applicable statements and/or rectifications. A reduced period of 5 days has been established due to the urgency of starting the administrative actions related to the organization.

3. Publication of the final list of accepted and excluded applicants: the Governing Body, after taking into account the statements and/or rectifications, will publish the final list of accepted and excluded applicants for the procedure on the websites <https://acts.webs.upv.es/> and <https://polinizados.webs.upv.es/>. In addition, it will notify all interested parties via email.
4. Scoring: the Selection Committee will evaluate the applications based on the objective granting criteria established in Rule Five, and will issue the corresponding justified report.

The applications will be ordered from highest to lowest, based on the score obtained, thus determining the order of granting these awards.

The Selection Committee may declare any of the awards to be null and void due to the candidates not reaching the quality demanded or for other reasons that would be duly justified.

5. Proposed final decision: the Governing Body, taking into account the reports issued by the Selection Committee and the record, will prepare the



duly justified provisional final decision proposal, which will be published on the internal websites <https://acts.webs.upv.es/> and <https://polinizados.webs.upv.es/>

A period of 5 business days will be granted to submit the statements and/or attach the documents deemed appropriate for this proposed final decision.

Taking into account the statements provided, the Governing Body will elevate the proposed final decision to the Rector.

6. Final decision: the Rector will issue the justified final decision of the final granting, which will be published on the websites <https://acts.webs.upv.es/> and <https://polinizados.webs.upv.es/>

In addition, they will notify all interested parties via email.

The beneficiaries must confirm the acceptance of the award or decline it within 5 days following the notification thereof.

If the final decision on the granting needs to be modified due to a violation of the requirements, refusal of the winner or for any other justified reason, a list of reserves will be established with the scores associated with each participant. If this list does not exist, the award will be deemed null and void.

For notification purposes, the final results will be published at <https://acts.webs.upv.es/> <https://polinizados.webs.upv.es/> no later than **May 3, 2024**. In addition, the beneficiaries will be notified via the email address they provide to the Universitat Politècnica de València.

All decisions adopted must be justified.

TENTH. APPEALS



An administrative reconsideration appeal may be lodged against this contest and its bases before the UPV Rectorate, as well as against the decision of this Call, after having exhausted the administrative route, within a period of one month, counted from the date following its publication, as stipulated in articles 123 and 124 of Law 39/2015, of October 1, of the Common Administrative Procedure of Public Administrations, or a contentious-administrative appeal before the contentious-administrative jurisdiction bodies of the Valencian Community, within two months counted from the day following the day of the notification of this decision, in accordance with articles 14 and 46 of Law 29/1998, of July 13, regulating the Contentious-Administrative Jurisdiction.

ANNEX I
RULES OF THE CALL FOR POLINIZA DOS 2024 (URBAN ART MEETING)

1. PURPOSE

Within the program of activities for POLINIZA DOS 2024 (Urban Art Meeting), the Office of Cultural Action of the Vice-Rectorate of Art, Science, Society and Technology of the Universitat Politècnica de València is organizing an event featuring artistic interventions on campus. The interventions will consist of murals on an architectural surface related to the plastic material and symbolically with its urban environment, as well as ephemeral interventions in the space.

2. PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS

The Call is open to artists of adult age interested in participating in the event individually or as a group.

Once the Committee has made the selection, applicants must present a project aimed at executing a painting intervention from **May 13 to 17, 2024** (both inclusive), each day between 10:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. on the walls designated for that purpose at UPV's Vera Campus site.

3. REGISTRATION APPLICATION AND DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION

The period for submitting applications will be open from the day following the publication of this excerpt in the Official Gazette of the Generalitat Valenciana until **March 31** (both inclusive). To submit the form, the applicant must complete the application available at <https://acts.webs.upv.es/> and <https://polinizados.webs.upv.es/>. This request must include any link that connects to the applicant's digital portfolio or website with the work of the interested party.

4. SELECTION COMMITTEE

The Selection Committee will be comprised of the following members of the Universitat Politècnica de València: the Director of the Office for Cultural Action, the Vice Dean of Culture of the Faculty of Fine Arts, a professor in the Faculty of Fine Arts, the commissioner of POLINIZA DOS, the coordinator of POLINIZA DOS and one student body representative. After evaluating the information provided, the Selection Committee will select the participants for POLINIZA DOS.

The jury will operate in accordance with the Rules of the collegiate bodies established in Law 40/2015 on the legal regime of the public sector.

5. EVALUATION CRITERIA

The grants will be awarded through the competitive contest regime.

The applicable evaluation scales and criteria will be objective, non-discriminatory and must respect the principle of equality.

The applications submitted will be scored based on the following criteria:

- Academic record and/or artistic curriculum: 30%
- Portfolio (website, social media, etc): 70%

6. FINAL DECISION

The final decision will be issued by the Rector within the 5 days following the acceptance of the proposal. The short time window is due to the administrative challenges posed as a result of being an international call.

The final decision on the competition will be announced via the 'Culture' link at <https://acts.webs.upv.es/> and <https://polinizados.webs.upv.es/>

7. AWARD

The total amount of the grant is 3,000 euros, charged to the 009010000-422-47110 budget line. The award, for each artist or group will be 600 gross euros (to be paid via bank transfer) for each intervention completed. There will be a maximum of five interventions (individual or group). The organization also assumes the costs of travel, accommodation and living expenses of each artist. In addition, they will be provided with the materials necessary for executing the project. The awards will be subject to the corresponding tax withholding.

On occasions, and upon request by the jury, a runner-up may be included to recognize the merit of a proposal that was not awarded. This runner-up will not receive any payment.

8. PROJECT EXECUTION CONDITIONS

The person or group selected undertakes to carry out the project submitted within the period established by these Rules.

For its part, the Vice Rectorate of Art, Science, Technology and Society undertakes to disseminate the award through its customary means and provide the infrastructure and materials necessary to execute each project selected.

The people selected grant UPV free-of-charge the rights of reproduction, distribution, public communication and transformation for their works. UPV may possess these works for any amount of time and global in nature. It may also determine how long it remains in the performance space, which in some cases, may be longer than the period between consecutive editions.

9. ACCEPTANCE OF THE RULES

Participation in this Call implies full agreement and acceptance of these Rules.
